



The City of Chicopee has transitioned to daily updates as the COVID-19 situation has warranted a centralized/increase in the distribution of information. These updates are intended to keep all informed of the actions being taken to reduce the impacts of Coronavirus on the community.

On Wednesday, June 9, 2021, the following City of Chicopee Departments have reported:

Mayor's Office

- The state reported there were 100 new cases yesterday for a total of 3,805 open cases which continues the decline in infections and is the lowest since March of 2020
- The state numbers indicated 2 new deaths yesterday
- The state had 173 cases in hospitals, with 57 in an ICU. The average age of hospitalization dropped to 58 years old
- The state seven day average positivity is 0.52%
- Testing is continuing with 22,264 molecular tests reported and brings the cumulative tests to 23,203,816 tests
- The state numbers continue to decline
- There is a new variant, the Delta variant, which is highly contagious. It has not been found in Chicopee, but accounts for over 6% of the new infections in the country
- The vaccination will work against the Delta variant which was from India
- Today we had zero new cases in Chicopee
- COVID is not on the front page of the newspaper today
