



The City of Chicopee has transitioned to daily updates as the COVID-19 situation has warranted a centralized/increase in the distribution of information. These updates are intended to keep all informed of the actions being taken to reduce the impacts of Coronavirus on the community.

On Wednesday, June 23, 2021, the following City of Chicopee Departments have reported:

#### **Mayor's Office**

- The state reported there were 33 new cases yesterday for a total of 1,838 open cases which continues the decline in infections
- The state numbers indicated 1 new death yesterday
- The state had 103 cases in hospitals, with 35 in an ICU. The average age of hospitalization was 59 years old
- The state seven day average positivity is 0.34%
- Testing is continuing with 20,322 molecular tests reported and brings the cumulative tests to 23,605,912 tests
- The state numbers continue to decline
- There is a new variant, the Delta variant, which is highly contagious. We have a small number of cases in Chicopee, and it accounts for over 20% of the new infections in the country

  - A total of 4,474 cases to date
- We have coordinated a mobile vaccination clinic at Wisniowski Park and at J. Polep Distributors
- The additional part –time nurse will help with contact tracing if needed
