

Chicopee Country Club

Rules, Regulation and Dress Codes

- 1 Children under ten (10) are not permitted on the golf course unless accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- 2 Damage to Chicopee Country Club property shall be paid for by the person responsible.
- 3 Chicopee Country Club will not be responsible for loss or damage to property of anyone using these facilities.
- 4 No one under the age of seventeen (17) will be permitted to drive power carts.
- 5 Unless otherwise posted, all power carts shall be required to stay on the cart paths. When posted, the ninety degree rule must be followed. Power carts are not allowed on the tee areas or within thirty (30) feet of the green except when on cart paths.
- 6 Hand carts are not permitted within twenty (20) feet of the green and may not be rolled onto any part of the tee areas, greens, through bunkers, or between bunkers and greens.
- 7 Replace divots, repair ball marks, rake bunkers.
- 8 Each player must have their own separate bag of clubs.
- 9 The course will be marshaled. Slow players may be asked to leave.
- 10 All golfers are responsible for personal injury or property damage they cause. All incidents must be reported to the pro shop.
- 11 **NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are allowed on the course during public play. No party or ice coolers are allowed on the course or on rental carts. Use of any controlled substance on the course or in any Chicopee Country Club facility will result in criminal prosecution. Substance abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.

Dress Codes

Men's: The following is regarded as appropriate dress: golf shows (spikeless only), mid-thigh walking shorts, golf shirts with sleeves and collars (neat collarless shirts may also be worn), and slacks or neat jeans.
Unacceptable attire: Tank tops, bare tops, sweat pants, cut-offs.

Ladies: The following is regarded as appropriate dress: golf shoes (spikeless only), slacks, neat jeans, mid-thigh shorts, skirts, skorts, tops with at least 2" wide shoulder straps.
Unacceptable attire: Halter and strapless tops, bare midriffs, high heels.

Lightning Detection System

Chicopee Country Club is equipped with a lightning detection system. If a siren sounds (solid tone) & strobe light is on **return to club house immediately**. If siren sounds (3) five second intermittent blasts and the strobe light is off, check with golf staff to safely return. This system is not absolute protection so please use common sense.
