



The City of Chicopee has transitioned to daily updates as the COVID-19 situation has warranted a centralized/increase in the distribution of information. These updates are intended to keep all informed of the actions being taken to reduce the impacts of Coronavirus on the community.

On Wednesday, July 7, 2021, the following City of Chicopee Departments have reported:

#### **Mayor's Office**

- The Eastfield Mall vaccination and testing site has closed after five months of providing vaccinations
- There is free drive through testing at Holyoke Community College, Lot M, on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday from 7:00 am to 11:00 am and Tuesday and Thursday from 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm
- We need to continue to encourage people to get vaccinated
- Pride on 167 Chicopee Street will have vaccinations on Sundays, July 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup>
- Ray Ash Park pool will be opened this week and National Night Out, (NNO), will be Monday August 2<sup>nd</sup>. We will try to have the vaccination bus there at NNO
- The state reported there were 269 new cases yesterday which is an increase
- The state numbers indicated 6 new death yesterday
- The state had 81 cases in hospitals, with 26 in an ICU
- The state seven day average positivity is 0.42% which is a slight increase
- Testing is continuing with 65,702 molecular tests reported and brings the cumulative tests to 23, 947,953 tests
- The state numbers while low are showing a slight increase
